## Why HIRE?

A Better Way to Find the Right Person for the Job!

HIRE is an innovative subsidized employment program that supports the business community.

You train your worker your way and WfBC helps with the pay!

We pre-qualify all candidates to meet your requirements as well as the program requirements.

## HIRE On-the-Job Training Program

HIRE On-the-Job Training programs allow businesses to train new employees once they start working, for half of the usual cost of hiring a new employee. Workforce Boulder County will pay 50% of the wages for 3-5 months (up to \$5,000) while you train the new employee in their job.

After the training period is completed, the employee's salary is paid completely by the business.

You must post your job on Connecting Colorado to qualify ([www.connectingcolorado.com](http://www.connectingcolorado.com)). In addition to qualifying through skills for the jobs you post, applicants in this program must be residents of Boulder County and also meet certain qualifications set by WfBC. You cannot hire someone as a participant in this program prior to receiving a signed contract from WfBC. *We cannot fill a position that is open as a result of layoffs.*

## HIRE Who?

HIRE primarily refers and screens workers who have exhausted their unemployment benefits and meet other specified requirements, including those set by the business.

Program requirements include the following:

- Participants must be residents of Boulder County
- They must be legally able to work in the US
- The total household income must be less than \$75,000
- There must be at least one child under the age of 18 living in the household.
