Why HIRE?

HIRE is an innovative subsidized employment program that supports the business community by providing a paid workforce for short term projects.

HIRE Interns are skilled and ready to work.

You get someone qualified to help with your projects *and* you help get people back to work.

HIRE Internship Program

The HIRE Internship program allows non-profit businesses and government agencies to meet short-term project employment needs.

Applicants are hired by Workforce Boulder County and placed in your business or agency for one to three months (up to \$5000 in wages and FICA). We also pay Workman's Compensation. Multiple projects will be considered.

You must apply using the [Call for Projects](#) form. In addition to qualifying through skills for the jobs you post, applicants in this program must be residents of Boulder County and also meet certain qualifications set by WfBC. WfBC will recruit and refer applicants that meet our eligibility requirements. You can then determine which applicants meet your qualifications. You may not hire someone as part of this program prior to receiving a signed contract from WfBC.

We cannot fill a position that is open as a result of layoffs.

HIRE Who?

HIRE primarily refers and screens workers who have exhausted their unemployment benefits and meet other specified requirements, including those set by the business.

Program requirements include the following:

- Participants must be residents of Boulder County
- They must be legally able to work in the US
- The total family income must be less than \$75,000
- There must be at least one child under the age of 18 in the family.
